Cascade

There is no dump station available and no dumping of grey/waste water allowed. This area has historic attractions. Reservations must be made 4 days in advance. The chalk cliffs, while beautiful to behold, are very dangerous. View from a distance; resist the urge to climb them. No discharge of firearms or fireworks. A fee of \$5 for extra vehicles will be collected at the campground.

Directions: From Buena Vista, Colorado, take Highway 285 south to Nathrop, Colorado. Turn west on County Road 162, travel 9 miles to the Cascade Campground.

Chalk Lake
