FULL DAY trips begin at the famous Buena Vista Whitewater Park where attention-grabbing rapids fill your morning. Sweeping views of 14,000 foot peaks line the approach to the stunning depths of boulder-strewn Browns Canyon. After lunch, we take on more heart-pounding whitewater, including the infamous Seidel's Suckhole. A HALF DAY trip is perfect if you are short on time as we blast through 10 miles of the heart of Browns Canyon's best whitewater.
